Comprehensive

Our clinical staff are Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselors, trained by Hazelden Graduate School of Addiction Counseling. Through the use of the ASAM (American Society of Addiction Medicine) patient replacement dimensions; the DSM IV criteria; client self report and collateral contacts we synthesize a diagnosis. These tools allow us to distinguish the “normal” user from the chemically abusive or chemically dependent individual.

Assessments

The primary objective of our assessments is to determine the degree to which chemical use may be problematic in our client’s life. We begin the process with a “tabula rasa” and make no assumptions, even though are clients often arrive by way of DWI. The assessment is a process of discovery, based on the honest disclosures of our clients, their families and certain facts. We believe chemical dependency is a disease and requires a clinically appropriate solution.

Protocols

Once an assessment is completed, we provide a clinical recommendation based on the client’s medical needs. We believe legal requirements and clinical needs are not always aligned. While an assessment and a DWI education class may suffice for the court, it may not be enough to ensure the sobriety and the wellness of our client. Our recommendations are based on the client’s needs and professional and ethical mandate.

Programs

Intervent consulting provides a variety of services based on the understanding that alcoholism and addiction affect not just the addict, but the family as a whole. We offer an ongoing “recovery integration program;” which helps to monitor and to assist our clients in applying recovery techniques in their daily lives. At times, this is a reasonable alternative for clients who either warrant a less restrictive level of care or simply refuse to undergo residential treatment.
